Parent Council Annual General Meeting

Our Parent Council Annual General Meeting will take place on Thursday, November 20 at 6:30 pm in the school library. Nominations and elections of Council executive positions will take place, as well as the presentation of the 2024 -2025 financial statements. All parents and guardians are welcome to attend.

Book Fair

The school will be holding a Book Fair from November 26 – 30. Like our book fair last year, students will have an opportunity to preview items and create a wish list. The book fair will be open during our Demonstration of Learning on November 26.

Demonstration of Learning

Our first Demonstration of Learning will take place on Wednesday, November 26 from 3:00 pm – 7:00pm. This is a great opportunity to come in and see what your child has been learning and to connect with your child's teacher.

Reading Stars

We are excited to launch year 2 of our school's literacy initiative *Reading Stars* on Monday, December 1. Each grade level is asked to read a certain number of minutes each night and to record their reading on a tracking sheet provided by the school. Once your child has filled in one row on their tracking sheet, cut it off, have your child return it to school, and place it in the jar for their grade level. At the end of the month, one name will be drawn from each grade level, and the student will win a book! The more the students read the more chances they have to win! Remember reading does not have to be done independently. It can also be you reading aloud to your child, watching a story being read online, listening to audio books or reading comic books.
